

PowerPoint Presentation Requirements

Here are the requirements for the PowerPoint presentation. Remember that all presentations should teach the audience something and have lots of detail.

Students PowerPoint presentations should include the following:

1. Title slide
2. Outline slide
3. A combined total of at least 5 of the following items, photos, images of clip art, videos, sound.
4. Between 8 and 16 slides
5. Information that teaches the class something.
6. Each slide should include a title and 2 to 5 main or supporting points.
7. Slides **MUST** be readable.
8. Slide background should not be distracting and should remain constant throughout the presentation.
9. All videos and sound must be less than 2 minutes long unless approved by Mr. Lange
10. You must elaborate on at least 2 main points in your slideshow. (That means you tell us something in more detail than it is written on the slide.)

Verbal/Visual Presentation grading requirements:

10 pts: Presentation is organized and makes sense.

10 pts: Presentation well rehearsed, and student is able to explain in detail.

6 pts: Student elaborates (explains in greater detail) at least 2 points during their presentation.

4 pts: Presentation actually teaches the audience something.

5 pts: Audience is able to understand and hear the presenter (student)

5 pts: Student attempts to answer questions about their presentation.
